

#### MEMORANDUM

TO: THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL

SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL SCHEDULE

**ISSUE:** City Council Schedule.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That City Council:

- (1) Receive the revised calendar which includes:
  - the City's 14<sup>th</sup> annual homeownership fair on Saturday, April 5 (location to be determined);
  - the opening ceremony for the second span of the Woodrow Wilson Bridge on Thursday, May 15 at 11:00 a.m.; and
- (2) Set a date for a breakfast meeting at INOVA Alexandria Hospital in late November or early December. We will provide dates for Council at the October 23 Council meeting; and
- (3) Discuss potential dates in 2007 or 2008 for a Community Educational Summit to be held jointly with the School Board at T.C. Williams High School.

**DISCUSSION:** The Woodrow Wilson Bridge second span will be completed in May and a formal dedication is set for Thursday, May 15. We also will be working with Prince George's County staff to plan a community day that weekend to enable those who wish to do so to walk across the new bridge before it is opened to vehicular traffic.

The INOVA Alexandria Hospital City/Hospital Task Force hospital representatives would like to host a breakfast and tour of the hospital for Council in late November or early December. We will have suggested dates for Council on Tuesday night.

The Mayor has proposed that the City Council and School Board host a Community Education Summit. The City Council/School Board Subcommittee will discuss this at its October 22 meeting. We will follow-up on this discussion at Tuesday's Council meeting.
