SUBJECT: ORDINANCE TO INCREASE PARKING METER RATES IN PARKING METER ZONE 3

**<u>ISSUE</u>**: Consideration of a proposed ordinance to increase the parking meter rates to be charged in Parking Meter Zone 3 (map on Attachment 1).

**<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: That City Council approve the attached proposed ordinance to increase the parking meter rates in Parking Meter Zone 3 to \$1.25 per hour on first reading, and set it for public hearing, second reading and final passage on May 16, 2009.

**DISCUSSION:** As a part of FY 2009 budget, City Council approved a rate of \$1.00 per hour for meters Citywide. This increased the meter rates from \$0.75 per hour in Zone 1 (Old Town – east of Washington Street) and from \$0.50 per hour in Zone 2 (Old Town – west of Washington Street) to \$1.00 per hour, which was the rate established for Parking Meter Zone 3 (Carlyle area) when that zone was created. The FY 2010 budget as adopted by City Council reflected a proposed increase of fees in Parking Meter Zone 3 (Carlyle area) from \$1.00 per hour to \$1.25 per hour. This ordinance will change the City Code to reflect the rate set forth in the budget.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The increase of 25 cents per hour in Parking Meter Zone 3 will generate approximately \$54,000 in additional General Fund revenue annually. This additional revenue was included in the FY 2010 budget as adopted.
