

**ISSUE:** City Council Schedule.

**<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: That City Council receive the revised calendar which includes:

- the Waterfront Plan Boat Tour on the *Miss Mallory*, Saturday, May 30 from 9:00 a..m to 12:00 p.m., City Marina at Cameron and Union Street;
- the dedication of the Frank Mann baseball field at Four Mile Run on Friday, June 5 at 6:30 p.m., at 3700 Commonwealth Avenue;
- the addition of DASH issues to the Monday, June 22 Council work session with the Planning Commission on the King Street Retail Study; and
- the Mayor's Institute on City Design for Braddock Fields visit on Monday, June 29 and Tuesday, June 30 (details to be provided).

**DISCUSSION:** As part of the Waterfront small area planning process, the Planning and Zoning staff is inviting Council and members of the public to take a guided tour of the Alexandria waterfront by boat from 9:00 a.m. to noon on Saturday, May 30. The tour, which will take place on the Potomac Riverboat Company's *Miss Mallory*, will also enable participants to see nearby current or future waterfront development projects in the District of Columbia. The tour is free but registration is required.

The Mayor's Institute on City Design is following up with an Alexandria exercise using Braddock Fields as the subject matter on Monday, June 29 and Tuesday, June 30. The Planning and Zoning Department will be providing further details.
