

SUBJECT: ALEXANDRIA FUND FOR HUMAN SERVICES FY 2010 GRANT AWARDS

ISSUE: City Council receipt of the report of the Alexandria Fund for Human Services (AFHS) grant awards, which includes the Children's Fund, Youth Fund and Community Partnership Fund, for FY 2010.

<u>RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: That City Council:

- (1) Receive the report of the Alexandria Fund for Human Services FY 2010 grant awards, which includes the Children's Fund, Youth Fund and Community Partnership Fund grant awards; and
- (2) Thank the members of the citizen review panels of the Early Childhood Commission, Youth Policy Commission, and Community Partnership Fund for their leadership in the allocation process.

DISCUSSION: The Alexandria Fund for Human Services is the umbrella fund through which the Department of Human Services staff coordinates and administers grants and special initiatives for the three human service grant funds; the Children's Fund, the Youth Fund and the Community Partnership Fund. The Children's Fund assists organization in providing quality early childhood education programs and comprehensive services for at-risk children, birth through age five. The Youth Fund supports activities that promote positive youth development and the developmental asset approach for youth, ages six to 21. The Community Partnership supports human services priorities that address self-sufficiency, prevention, and protection and treatment.

All grants are awarded on a competitive basis. Review panels evaluate applications and make funding recommendations based on the selection criteria set forth in the Request for Grant Proposal guidelines.

In recognition of the current economic downturn, the City recognizes the need to be flexible where funding is targeted and returned to a one-year funding cycle. This provides the City with the ability to shift priorities as needs change. For the AFHS Community Partnership Fund, special consideration was given to programs that historically provide essential safety net services for the City's most vulnerable clients. City Council was notified of this change in a memorandum dated, January 30, 2009.

City Council approved an appropriation of \$2,015,098, a decrease of 13 percent, for the Alexandria Fund for Human Services for FY 2010, of which \$899,098 is for the Children's Fund, \$274,672 for the Youth Fund and \$841,328 for the Community Partnership Fund. Citizen review panels, with support from the staff of the Department of Human Services, evaluated all proposals based on established criteria and the quantified rating system included in the AFHS Request for Grant Proposal guidelines. There were 67 proposals, requesting \$3,384,986. AFHS grant allocations will support 53 programs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for the Alexandria Fund for Human Services awards of \$2,015,098 for FY 2010 is included in the City's FY 2010 Budget. Grant funding is for a one-year period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Funding in subsequent years is contingent upon City Council approval in future City Budgets. Copies of all of the proposals are available for review at the Department of Human Services, 2525 Mt. Vernon Avenue.
