ISSUE: City Council Schedule.

RECOMMENDATION: That City Council:

(1) Decide whether or not it wishes to change the date of the first legislative meeting in November from Tuesday, November 11, to Wednesday, November 19 because of a conflict with Veterans Day and the annual National League of Cities Conference.

We recommend holding the Saturday public hearing on November 15 and not changing that date.

- (2) Schedule a work session on the DASH Long Range Plan at 5:30 p.m. before the first legislative meeting in November; and
- (3) Receive the revised calendar which includes the Spring for Alexandria Community Service day on Friday, May 1 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. with a celebration on Market Square from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: At its September 9 legislative meeting Council decided to make a determination at the September 23 legislative meeting on whether or not to change the dates of the first legislative meeting and public hearing meeting in November due to conflicts with Veterans Day and the National League of Cities (NLC) Conference. Since then the Mayor has advised us he will not be attending the NLC Conference.

I recommend that Council move the first legislative meeting in November to Wednesday, November 19 and keep the public hearing date of Saturday, November 15.
