ANNUAL COMMITTEE ATTENDANCE REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008

ISSUE: Receipt of the Annual Report on Committee Attendance for Fiscal Year 2008.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That City Council: (1) receive the report; (2) vacate the 13 positions listed on pages one and two of the report; and (3) authorize the Executive Secretary for Boards and Commissions to advertise the vacancies.

DISCUSSION: Section 2-4-7(i) of the City Code requires appointees to committees to attend at least 75 percent of the meetings of the committees on which they serve. There are 55 City boards, committees, commissions and task forces that are required to file annual attendance reports with the Executive Secretary for Boards and Commissions by July 15 of each year. This report summarizes attendance reports from 52 of the 55 City boards, committees and commissions. Three committees have not submitted the attendance reports for Fiscal Year 2008. These committees are listed on page four of the attachment. When all seven committee reports are received, staff will docket a supplemental attendance report for Council's consideration.

The 52 City boards, committees, and commissions included in this report held 436 meetings. Nine of the 52 groups listed members (a total of 13 persons) who did not attend 75 percent of the groups' meetings (three more than last year). The names of the persons who will be removed for failure to comply with the attendance requirements are listed on pages one and two of the attached report. Each of the 13 persons has been notified by letter of their attendance record. These persons may reapply for appointment with other new applicants when the positions are advertised.



SUBJECT:	AMENDED ATTENDANCE REPORT FROM THE GANG PREVENTION COMMUNITY TASK FORCE

Today, I received an amended attendance report from Co-Chairman Timothy Lovain of the Gang Prevention Community Task Force. I have been advised by the Task Force staff, Mike Mackey, that the original report erroneously reported two unexcused absences for James Williams, who is the NAACP representative for this group. The corrected report shows one unexcused absence and one excused absence. With the excused absence, Mr. Williams will meet the 75 percent attendance requirement and should not be removed for failure to comply with the City Code Section 2-4-7(i). In light of the revised report, I recommend that Council delete Mr. Williams from the list of persons to be removed for failure to comply with the attendance requirements. This means that only 12 persons will be removed.
