 - the City Council Retreat on Saturday, October 25 at 9:45 a.m. at the Transportation and Environmental Services Department and Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities Department Offices and Facilities Maintenance Building at 2900 Business Center Drive;
 - a work session on DASH Long Range Plan at 5:30 p.m. before Council's Wednesday, November 19 legislative meeting in the Council work room;
 - Virginia Municipal League (VML) Day and Joint Alexandria/Arlington dinner with the state legislative delegations on Thursday, February 5 in Richmond;
