That Chapter 4 of Title 2 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained by the addition of the 13 following new article and sections to read as follows: 14 15 16 ARTICLE X – ALEXANDRIA BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION 17 18 Sec. 2-4-190 Creation, composition and organization. 19 20 (a) There is hereby established a commission known as the Alexandria Beautification 21 Commission ("Commission"). 22 The Commission shall consist of 16 members to be appointed by the city council. All 16 members shall be citizens of the City of Alexandria. 23 24 Members of the commission shall be appointed in the manner prescribed in article (c) 25 A of this title. 26 Members shall serve for a term of two years. Terms shall be staggered so that no (d) 27 more than half the commission will come up for reappointment in any year. 28 29 Sec. 2-4-191 Functions. 30 The functions of the Commission shall be as follows: (a) 31 to serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council and the citizens of Alexandria (1) 32 on all matters related to the beautification of the City; and 33 to serve in an advisory capacity regarding the beautification of portals to the City. (2) The Commission force shall hold at least four regular meetings each year, and as 34 (b) 35 many special meetings as the commission may deem advisable. The Commission force is empowered to adopt rules and regulations in regard to 36 (c) 37 procedure so long as the same are not inconsistent with the city code, including, but not limited to, the establishment of committees through which it may carry on its functions and purpose. 38 39 A Commission chair, vice-chair and secretary shall be elected annually by the 40 Commission members at the organizational meeting designated by the Commission. 41 The Alexandria Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities and such 42 other departments of the city as the city manager may direct shall provide administrative and 43 logistical support to the Commission and its chair.
