ORDINANCE NO. 4614

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 12-9-12 (COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT; TERMS AND COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS; FILLING VACANCIES; OFFICERS) of Article B (ALEXANDRIA COMMISSION ON AGING) of Chapter 9 (AGING), Title 12 (EDUCATION, SOCIAL SERVICES AND WELFARE) of the Code of The City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 12-9-12 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to read as follows:

The commission shall consist of 21 members appointed at large by the city council to terms of three years each. Any vacancy may be filled by the council for the unexpired portion of a term. Eleven members of the commission shall be 60 years of age or older, including minority individuals. Of the remaining 10 members, five four shall be citizens at large, one shall be a representative of older persons, one shall be a representative of a health care provider organization, one shall be a representative of a supportive service provider, one shall be an individual with leadership experience in a volunteer organization, <u>one shall be a member of the Alexandria Commission for</u> Women and one shall be a local elected official, or his or her designee. A chairperson, vice chairperson and secretary shall be chosen annually by a two-thirds vote of the commission members present. Members shall serve without compensation but may receive such reimbursement for expenses as the council may from time to time allow.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
