CEREMONY

On behalf of all the members of the Alexandria Fire Department, I would like to invite you to a recognition of support ceremony on Tuesday, January 24, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. at Fire Station 201, 317 Prince Street. As our Department begins to increase our staffing levels to four-person minimum on all emergency suppression apparatus, we would like to publicly thank the Alexandria City Council for its support.

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) has issued a nationally recognized staffing standard of four firefighters on all responding apparatus. Studies have concluded that this increase in staffing has significantly reduced the number and the severity of injuries compared with three-person staffing.

In the past, staffing levels have in large measure been viewed as a matter of firefighting efficiency as opposed to firefighter safety. We are proud that we can now make the health and safety of our firefighters, firefighter/rescuers, and medics a priority.

I hope you will be able to join us for this brief ceremony. We would like to take the opportunity to publicly thank everyone who participated and supported this process.
