ISSUE: Sign

APPLICANT: Houseworks

LOCATION: 421 South Washington Street

ZONE: CL Commercial

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the application as submitted.



I. ISSUE:

The applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for the installation of a 30" by 30" MDO hanging sign reading "HOUSE WORKS INTERIORS". The proposed sign will be double-faced and mounted to the building face using an existing 36" black scroll bracket that was previously approved by the board and is attached to the wall with 1/4" lag bolts with anchors. The proposed sign will be painted blue with white lettering. The applicant is also requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for white, reverse cut address lettering which would be applied to the glass transom above the front door. The proposed lettering would read "412 S. Washington St." and be a total of 6" tall and 16" wide.

II. HISTORY:

The row of buildings at 419 through 425 South Washington Street was built circa 1880 according to the tax assessment records. These brick rowhouses feature typical Victorian characteristics including projecting bays, arched lintels, and decorative brick corbeling at the cornice level.

III. ANALYSIS:

The proposed sign complies with the zoning ordinance requirement.

Staff's opinion is that the proposed design and size of the sign are appropriate in this location. Staff believes that the proposed sign meets the recommendations of the *Design Guidelines*.

IV. STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the application as submitted.




Figure 1 Proposed Sign
