I. <u>ISSUE</u>:

The applicant is requesting approval of a Certificate of Appropriateness to install a black metal fence between the north corner of the Prescott condominium building on North Henry Street and the north property line. The fence will be the same height and style as the existing fence located at the corner of Cameron Street and Fayette Street. The fence will be approximately 15' and will be set back approximately 5' from the front of the building.

The fence is being proposed to prevent unauthorized foot traffic.

II. HISTORY:

The Prescott Condominium building was approved by the Parker-Gray Board on June 23, 2004 (BAR Case #2004-0125). The project has just been completed. The mostly four-story condominium building containing 64 dwelling units replaced a service station and warehouse.

III. ANALYSIS:

Fencing complies with Zoning Ordinance requirements.

Staff fully supports the application. The proposed fence matches existing fencing located in the project.

IV. STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval as submitted.
