I. MINUTES

1. Conceptual review of park for James Bland Project.

SPEAKERS

Mr. Greg Shron, the applicant, presented the background on the park and described the proposed design. He also noted that the maintenance of the park was a neighborhood issue.

BOARD DISCUSSION

Ms. Kelley suggested that rubber curbing be considered instead of concrete around the play area.

Mr. Duffy noted that the durability of materials is very important to consider for the longevity of the park. He also commended the design concept of the park, thus far.

Ms. Rankin questioned the objective of the park and asked who the intended users were. She stressed that it needed a significant play area for neighborhood children.

2. Adoption of a Roof Materials policy for the Boards of Architectural Review

Staff presented the proposed policy. Ms. Kelly suggested including the words "in the historically appropriate style" at the end of the first sentence in section B2 Previously Replaced Windows. On a motion by Mr. Duffy, seconded by Mr. Meick, the Board adopted the policy, as amended, 6-0.

3. Adoption of a Windows policy for the Boards of Architectural Review

Staff presented the proposed policy. On a motion by Mr. Meick, seconded by Ms. Rankin, the Board adopted the policy as submitted, 6-0.
